

## Work Task B3: Achii Hanyo Rearing Station

<b>Partners:</b>	Colorado River Indian Tribes (CRIT) U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FWS)
<b>Contact:</b>	Tom Burke, LC-8300
<b>Purpose:</b>	Continue to develop this native fish rearing facility to contribute to the Fish Augmentation Program.
<b>Conservation Measures:</b>	BONY3 and BONY4
<b>Long-term Goal(s):</b>	Develop, maintain and operate facility for rearing and research of bonytail.
<b>Location:</b>	Achii Hanyo, Colorado River Indian Tribes Reservation, south of Parker, Arizona
<b>FY2006 Estimate:</b>	\$25,000 for labor and materials to support continued work on office building, water intakes, earthen berms, fish collection kettles and similar facility improvements.
<b>FY2007 Estimate:</b>	\$50,000 for fish rearing.
<b>FY2008 Estimate:</b>	\$100,000.
<b>Project Description:</b>	Complete construction of the maintenance building, which will help facilitate rearing of bonytail for release into the river. Rear 2,000-5,000 bonytail for release to Lake Havasu. Note: an additional \$50,000 is available to FWS through interagency agreement previously initiated.
